Kansas Juvenile Justice Authority- Comprehensive Plan Grant Application FY18

Patrick Klecker, Santa Fe Trails Community Corrections Director, and Sonja Channell, Deputy Director, presented for approval the comprehensive plan grant application FY18. The Kansas Department of Corrections was late getting the application out but did not change the date the application needed to be return. Mr. Klecker thanked the commissioners for the special meeting so they could turn in the application on time. This application outlines the use of the grant money for the fiscal year 2018.

Chairman Tasset moved to approve the Comprehensive Plan Grant Application FY18. Commissioner Snook seconded the motion. **Motion carried 3-0** .

Kansas Juvenile Justice Authority- FY18 Budget

Patrick Klecker, Santa Fe Trails Community Corrections Director, and Sonja Channell, Deputy Director, presented for approval the Juvenile Justice Authority FY18 budget. The Kansas Department of Corrections granted the same allocation's as last year. This grant is split between the Adult and the Juvenile justice programs. Commissioner Boys asked how many grants they receive. Mr. Klecker stated five pools of money, they receive Case Management, JISP, JIS, Title II grant and USD 443 gives \$20,000. Commissioner Boys asked if this budget is adjusted if they do not receive a grant like Title II. Mr. Klecker stated that yes; it would be adjusted if they do not receive a grant.

Commissioner Boys moved to approve the Kansas Juvenile Justice Authority FY18 budget. Commissioner Snook seconded the motion. County Administrator, JD Gilbert stated how complex the information is because the State sets these applications up.
