Provisionals Cast – 50

I am recommending that you count 39. This recommendation is based on the Provisional Chart provided in the Election Standards prepared by the Secretary of State's Office. I have attached a break down report by reason.

With the addition of the Provisional ballots, the total for the August 7th, election will be 2398 votes cast.

Reasons for Provisionals

- 2- They are registered as libertarian but wanted to vote.
- 9 -Not Registered in Ford County to vote.
- 1 – Mail ballot returned with no signature at all of any kind
- 2- Did not received their ballot in the mail that they requested
 - 1 Lost ballot that received in mail
 - 17 Address Changes
 - 18 Name Change
 - 2 Voter Error, pulled card before ballot printed
 - 19 Voter Stated they moved but filled out card with same address they were registered under
 - 12 Clerical Errors Could not find name in poll book.

Chairman Boys resumed the meeting at 10:35. Commissioner Tasset left the meeting during the recess. County Administrator J.D. Gilbert stood in place of Commissioner Tasset. Debbie Cox, Ford County Clerk/Election Officer was asked to give the count of the Governor's Race between Kris Kobach and Jeff Colyer. Ms. Cox reported that the total for Kris Kobach was 943 and for Jeff Colyer was 704.

Chairman Boys moved to certify the August 7, 2018 Primary Election with 2398 votes counted. Commissioner Snook seconded the motion. **Motion carried 3-0.**

Chairman Boys moved to adjourn at 10:44 Commissioner Snook seconded the motion.
