



Regulations for Political Signs

Location

- May be placed on private property or in the adjacent street right-of-way, but not obstruct the view of traffic signage or intersection or driveway visibility
- Must have the property owner's permission prior to placement.
- No signs may be placed on City-owned properties, including, but not limited to – parks, cemeteries, athletic fields, entertainment venues, public buildings. This also includes the adjacent street right-of-way.

Size

- Up to 8 square feet in area and 5 feet in height in Residential and Agriculture zones
- Up to 64 square feet in area and 15 feet in height in Commercial and Industrial zones

Timeframe

- May be placed up to 45 days prior to election, primary or general, in street right-of-way, any time prior on private property.
- Must be removed within 7 days following election from any location.

These regulations comply with the following:

- City Ordinance No. 3267 – Dodge City Zoning Ordinance
 - Kansas Statute 25-2711 – Placement of political signs during election period.
- * Any conflicts between the City Ordinance and Kansas Statute yield to the Statute.
