

# ROAD RECORD,

Entered according to Act of Congress, in the year 1875, by Geo. W. Crane

Road No. 74 Petition of L M McKinney and others. Filed June 14 1888

Be it Remembered, That, on the 14 day of June 1888, a Road Petition was filed in the office of the County Clerk of Ford County, Kansas, in words and figures as follows, to wit: We, the undersigned, resident householders of Ford County, Kansas, respectfully petition your honorable Board to cause to be laid out and established a County Road, as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the SE corner of Sec 13 Thirtien and running West between Sec 13 & 24 to the termination of the NW cor of Sec 13 in Twp 25 Range 24 County of Ford & State of Kans

## APPOINTMENT OF VIEWERS.

And afterward, to wit: on the 2 day of July 1888, the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners of said County, to wit: In the matter of the road of L M McKinney and others. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law has been substantially complied with, it is ordered that M O Research & Ad Adland Nelson Wiseman be appointed viewers of the road proposed in said petition, and that they meet on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of 18\_\_\_\_, at the \_\_\_\_\_, and with the County Surveyor proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, and make report of their proceedings to this Board on or before their next regular session.

## REPORT OF VIEWERS.

And afterward, to wit: on the 31 day of July 1888, the said viewers made their report, together with the report and plat of the County Surveyor, hereto attached, as follows, to wit: Pursuant to the notice and order of the Board, hereto attached, the undersigned viewers met as directed, on the 31 day of July 1888, at the place appointed, and having been duly sworn as required by law, we took to our assistance \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ as chain carriers, and \_\_\_\_\_ as marker, who were also duly sworn, and proceeded to view the route of the road petitioned for, which was surveyed under our direction by \_\_\_\_\_ County Surveyor, the field notes and plat of which survey are hereto attached, and after careful deliberation we are of the opinion that said road is practicable, and of public utility, and recommend that it be granted as located and surveyed. And we further recommend that said road be 60 feet wide.
