

# ROAD RECORD,

Road No. 197

**PETITION.**

Be it Remembered, That on the 11 day of April 1898, a road petition, signed by Geo. Beighard and Ford others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Ford County, Kansas, praying for locating of a certain road, described as follows, to-wit:

*Beginning where road #87 intersects with Range line between Ranges 24 & 25 Township 26 running thence North on township line to South West of North West quarter of section 19 Township 26 Range 24, thence East on half section line through section 19 one mile to intersect with road No. 011.*

**BOND.**

SAID PETITION was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by Geo. W. Beighard as principal, and Chris. Behl and S. M. Harner as sureties, in the penal sum of One hundred Dollars (\$ 100.00 ).

**Appointment of Viewers.**

WHEREUPON, Said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ORDERED, that C. M. Benson, C. F. Lopp and D. L. Sweeney be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet, in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the beginning of said road, in Dodge Township, on the 18 day of May 1898, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law; giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

AFTERWARD, TO-WIT: On the 6 day of July 1898, R. S. Crane County Clerk, presented to said Board, his certificate, under seal, setting forth that pursuant to law, he had caused public notice of said proposed road to be published in the Globe Republican (a weekly newspaper, published in Dodge City Kansas), for two consecutive weeks, and that said notice was so published in said newspaper on the 14 day of April 1898, the 21 day of April 1898, and the 28 day of April 1898; and had also caused similar notice to be posted to public view upon the bulletin board in his office from April 17 1898, to May 18th 1898, and similar notices to be publicly posted in the following places, to-wit:

**Final Order of Board of Co. Commissioners.**

WHEREUPON, On the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1898, the following action thereon was held by said Board of County Commissioners, to-wit:  
 Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ORDERED: That the Viewers' report of view, and report and plat of survey be adopted, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith; full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat, as Road No. 127; and the Trustees of Dodge Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That warrants issue to the following named persons, for amounts stated, in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road, to-wit:
