PETITION.

Be it Remembered, That on the 6 day of April 1889, a road petition, signed by C. L. Hickman and 22 others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Ford County, Kansas, praying for establishment of a certain road, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, in Township 28, Range 21 thence south on section lines $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles between sections 11 & 12, 13 and 14, 23 and 24, 25 & 26, 35 & 36, to and terminating at southeast corner of section 35 in said Township 28 range 21.

BOND.

SAID PETITION was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by _____ as principal, and _____ and _____ as sureties, in the penal sum of _____ Dollars (\$ _____).

Appointment of Viewers.

WHEREUPON, Said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ORDERED, that ~~Geo. Drencker, Geo. Mayall, W. J. Davis~~ be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet, in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the _____ of _____ Township, on the _____ day of _____ 188____, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law; giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

PROOF OF PUBLIC NOTICE.

AFTERWARD, TO-WIT: On the 7 day of May 1889, J. H. Connaway County Clerk, presented to said Board, his certificate, under seal, setting forth that pursuant to law, he had caused public notice of said proposed road to be published in Slobe-Republican (a weekly newspaper, published in Dodge City Kansas), for two consecutive weeks, and that said notice was so published in said newspaper on the 15 day of Apr 1889, the 22 day of Apr 1889 and the _____ day of _____ 188____; and had also caused similar notice to be posted to public view upon the bulletin board in his office from Apr 1 1889 to May 7 1889, and similar notices to be publicly posted in the following places, to-wit: from Apr 1 1889 to May 7 1889, at _____ Pleasant Valley, from _____ 188____, to _____ 188____, at _____ in _____ Township, from _____ 188____, to _____ 188____, at _____ in _____ Township, and had also caused record of same to be made in County Commissioners' Record, Volume "_____" Page "_____."

ROAD NOTICE

To Whom It May Concern:

In pursuance of an order made by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Ford in the State of Kansas, in regular session on the 6th day of April A. D. 1889, notice is hereby given that C. L. Hickman, W. S. Ham, O. M. Newby, C. H. Hartnett, C. G. Touer, W. A. Smith, Frances Dennis, Leslie Dennis, J. H. Biegel, J. N. Ramsey, J. T. Newby, O. B. Murphy, O. S. King, O. B. Taylor, Robert Spear, K. F. Stoner, S. P. Soper, D. Linsler, H. Boland, Sherman Tanner, Lizzie Carter, L. N. Parker and J. W. Davis, householders of said County, residing in the vicinity where it is proposed to lay out and establish the road below mentioned, have presented to said Board their certain petition, praying the laying out and establishment of a public road in said County, as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of section 11, in Township 28, range 21, thence south on section lines four and one half miles between sections 11 and 12, 13 and 14, 23 and 24, 25 and 26, 35 and 36, to and terminating at the southeast corner of section 35, in township 28, range 21.

Whereupon, the Board of County Commissioners finding that the said proposed road is to be located and extended along and upon certain section lines as above described, did, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 122 of the laws of 1872 as amended and modified by chapter 157 of the laws of 1877 of the State of Kansas, make an order and instruct the County Clerk of Ford county aforesaid to issue the same that public notice be given that the Board will take final action and make its final report upon said petition on the 7th day of May, 1889, and the road be declared established and the petition opened, unless, however, adverse claims presented by persons opposed to the establishment of said road shall show the petitioners to be in error.

It is further provided that all persons in favor of and opposed to the establishment of said road shall be given a hearing and that all claims for damages which may accrue by reason of establishing and opening said road shall be filed and presented to the Board of county commissioners for consideration on the 7th day of May, 1889.

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ORDERED: That the Viewers' report of view, and report and plat of survey be adopted, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith; full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat, as Road No. 260; and the Trustees of Gleason Valley Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That warrants issue to the following named persons, for amounts stated, in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road, to-wit:
