PETITION.

Be it Remembered, That on the 1st day of February 1911, a road petition, signed by H. M. Speer and 20 others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Ford County, Kansas, praying for establishing of a certain road, described as follows, to-wit:
 Beginning at the north east corner of sections 1, Township 26 south of range 24, thence running south along the range line between ranges 23 & 24 a distance of about two and one half miles to and terminating at the north boundary line of the A. T. & S. F. railway right of way where same intersects the said range line between said ranges 23 & 24 Ford County, Kansas.

BOND.

SAID PETITION, was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by H. M. Speer as principal, and Morgan Carter and E. S. Adams as sureties, in the penal sum of _____ Dollars (\$ _____).

Appointment of Viewers.

WHEREUPON, Said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ORDERED, that Nic Mayrath, W. J. Davies and G. W. Artwein be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet, in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the North east corner of Section One, in Grandview Township, on the 9 day of March 1911, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law; giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

PROOF OF PUBLIC NOTICE.

AFTERWARD, TO-WIT: On the 16 day of Feb'y 1911, H. M.  Take Notice, That a legal petition signed by H. M. Speer and 20 other householders of Grandview Township in said County, has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a public section line road, as follows, viz: Beginning at the northeast corner of Section 1, Township 26, south of range 24, thence running south along the range line between ranges 23 and 24, a distance of about two one half miles to and terminating at the north boundary line of the A. T. & S. F. Railway right of way, where same intersects the said range line between said ranges 23 and 24, Ford county, Kansas.
 And that said Board has appointed G. W. Artwein, W. J. Davies, and Nic Mayrath viewers, who will meet at the point of beginning of said road, as petitioned for, on the 8th day of March, 1911, and proceed to view said road, as the law directs, at which time and place all persons interested may attend and have a hearing.
