## Return of Surveyor

To the Honorable, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Ford:

The undersigned, the County Surveyor of said county, having been ordered by your honorable board to meet with W. H. Lewis and Coney A. Seabough, road viewers herein, on the 7 day of March, A. D. 1918, at .....

and survey, under their direction, a certain proposed road which had been petitioned for by ..... and others, herein before described, respectfully reports and returns to your honorable board, that on the ..... day of ....., A. # Action and Orders of the Board of County Commissioners

Whereas, application was made by written petition to the Board of County Commissioners of Ford County, Kansas, on February, 5th, 1918, by R. E. Bisbee and others for the location

of a public road described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point forty feet north of the northeast corner of Block 15, in the city of Ford, for the south line of said road, thence west along the north line of second street and terminating on the west line extended, of Main street.

And Whereas, the said Board of County Commissioners having found said petition a legal one, with approved bond, did appoint W. H. Davis, C. R. Aten, C. Orebaugh viewers of said road to be laid out and established, directing that said viewers shall meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the designated place of beginning of said road on March, 7th, 1918, at o'clock, and proceed to discharge their duties, with the assistance of the County Surveyor, who shall work only under the direction of the viewers.

## Report of View

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Ford County, Kansas:

The undersigned, who were appointed by your honorablebody to view the road petitioned for by R. E.
