ROAD RECORD,

(Prepared by State Commission, under Chapter 280, Laws of 1911.)

PETITION.

Be it Remembered, That on the 5th day of December, 1923, a road petition signed by L. A. Nelson and 15 others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Ford County, Kansas, praying for the establishment of a certain road described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the southeast corner of section 14 township 28 range 26, thence west on the section line as near as practicable five miles, between sections 14 and 23, 15 and 22, 16 and 21, 17 and 20, 18 and 19, and terminating at the southwest corner of section 18 township 28 range 26.

BOND.

SAID PETITION was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by L. A. Nelson as principal and S. B. Thompson and P. A. Reinest as sureties, in the penal sum of in the amount of all costs and expenses accruing in case the proceedings had in favor of said petition shall not be finally confirmed and established.

Appointment of Viewers.

WHEREAS, It appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, and the surety of the bond being considered sufficient, the bond was approved, and A. G. Frey and J. W. Shew and C. Crebaugh were appointed Viewers and Appraisers of the road which it is proposed to view with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the beginning of said route as described above, in Canon Township, on the 9th day of January, 1924, at o'clock M., and proceed to view the said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Proof of Public Notice.

AFTERWARD, To wit, on the 9th day of January, 1924, H. N. Kirkland, County Clerk, presented to said Board his certificate, under seal, setting forth that pursuant to law he had caused public notice of said proposed road view to be published in The Dodge City Journal, (a weekly newspaper published in Dodge City, Kansas,) for two consecutive weeks, and said notice was so published in said newspaper on the 12th day of December, 1923, the day of , 19 , and the 20th day of December, 1923, and had also caused similar notice to be posted to public view upon the bulletin board in his office from December 10th, 1923, to January 9th, 1924, and similar notices to be publicly posted in the following places, to wit: On a conspicuous place along the route of the proposed road

Order of Board
of County
Commissioners.

WHEREUPON, On the 6th day of March, 1927, the following action thereon was had by said Board of County Commissioners, to wit:

The reports of Viewers having been read before the Board of County Commissioners, and said report being favorable, and no legal objections appearing against the same, and the Board being satisfied that the establishing of such road will be of public utility, do hereby order the establishment of said road and (in case of alteration or establishment) designate the same as a public road. It is further ordered that proper record be made of said road proceedings, survey and plat, and that the County Surveyor direct and require the Township Trustee of township through which said road or any portion thereof runs, in case of mail routes or township roads, or County Engineer in case of State or County roads, to cause the road to be opened for public travel.

ALSO, It is hereby ordered that the award of damages be, and the same is hereby made, in accordance with the assessment of Viewers as per their report, with the following exceptions, viz.:

PROVIDED, That such sums shall become due and payable only upon the filing of a certificate from the Township Trustee or County Engineer, as the case may be, that the road has actually been opened for public travel.
