ROAD RECORD

(Prepared by State Commission, under Chapter 203, Laws of 1911.)

PETITION.

Be it Remembered, That on the 30 day of Sept, 1929, a road petition signed by P.J. Heiland and 13 others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Ford County, Kansas, praying for the Location of a certain road described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the South west corner at Section 28 T 26 R 24 Thence East between Section 28 and 33, one Mile

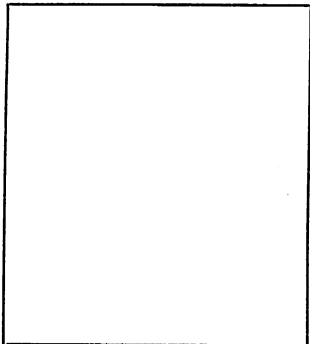
BOND.

SAID PETITION was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by P.T. Heiland as principal and Geo Peintner and H.J. Hessmann as sureties, in the penal sum of DOLLARS (\$...);

Appointment of Viewers.

WHEREAS, It appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, and the surety of the bond being considered sufficient, the bond was approved, and Chas H Redfield, H.B. Newzey and F.G. Frey were appointed Viewers and Appraisers of the road which it is proposed to locate with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the beginning of said route as described above, in Wheatland Township, on the 1 day of Oct, 1929, at 11:30 o'clock P.M., and proceed to view the said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Proof of Public Notice.



AFTERWARD, To wit, on the 30 day of Sept, 1929, H.N. Kinkead, County Clerk, presented to said Board his certificate, under seal, setting forth that pursuant to law he had caused public notice of said proposed road Location to be published in Daily Globe (a weekly newspaper published in Dodge City, Kansas,) for two consecutive weeks, and said notice was so published in said newspaper on the 12 day of Sept, 1929, the 19 day of Sept, 1929, and the day of Sept, 1929, and had also caused similar notice to be posted to public view upon the bulletin board in his office from Sept 4, 1929, to Sept 30, 1929, and similar notices to be publicly posted in the following places, to wit:

Order of Board  
of County  
Commissioners.

WHEREUPON, On the 9 day of Oct, 1929, the following action thereon was had by said Board of County Commissioners, to wit:

The reports of Viewers having been read before the Board of County Commissioners, and said report being favorable, and no legal objections appearing against the same, and the Board being satisfied that the Location of such road will be of public utility, do hereby order the Location of said road and (in case of alteration or establishment) designate the same as a Location road. It is further ordered that proper record be made of said road proceedings, survey and plat, and that the County Surveyor direct and require the Township Trustee of township through which said road or any portion thereof runs, in case of mail routes or township roads, or County Engineer in case of State or County roads, to cause the road to be opened for public travel.

ALSO, It is hereby ordered that the award of damages be, and the same is hereby made, in accordance with the assessment of Viewers as per their report, with the following exceptions, viz.:

PROVIDED, That such sums shall become due and payable only upon the filing of a certificate from the Township Trustee or County Engineer, as the case may be, that the road has actually been opened for public travel.
