

PETITION.

Be it Remembered, That on the 14 day of April, 1932, a road petition signed by B.P. Bolinger and 14 others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Ford County, Kansas, praying for the relocation of a certain road described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the South East Corner of the South West Quarter of Section 20 - Township 28 - Range 21, thence North along the Present County Road, a distance of five Miles, More or Less, and Terminating at the North East Corner of the North West Quarter of Section 32, Township 27, Range 21

BOND.

SAID PETITION was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by B.P. Bolinger as principal and Geo. H. McCaustland and as sureties, in the penal sum of DOLLARS (\$.....);

Appointment of Viewers.

WHEREAS, It appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, and the surety of the bond being considered sufficient, the bond was approved, and Chas. H. Redfield, H.B. Herzer and A.G. Frey were appointed Viewers and Appraisers of the road which it is proposed to relocate with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the beginning of said route as described above, in Pleasant Valley Township, on the 12 day of May, 1932, at 11:30 o'clock A.M., and proceed to view the said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Proof of Public Notice.

AFTERWARD, To wit, on the 12 day of May, 1932, T.E. Young, County Clerk, presented to said Board his certificate, under seal, setting forth that pursuant to law he had caused public notice of said proposed road to be published in D.C. Journal (a weekly newspaper published in Dodge City, Kansas), for two consecutive weeks, and said notice was so published in said newspaper on the 14 day of April, 1932, the 28 day of April, 1932, and the day of 1932, and had also caused similar notice to be posted to public view upon the bulletin board in his office from April 14, 1932, to April 28, 1932, and similar notices to be publicly posted in the following places, to wit:

WHEREUPON, On the.....day of....., 19....., the following action thereon was had by said Board of County Commissioners, to wit:

The reports of Viewers having been read before the Board of County Commissioners, and said report being favorable, and no legal objections appearing against the same, and the Board being satisfied that the relocation (vacation—alteration—establishment) of such road will be of public utility, do hereby order the relocation (vacation—alteration—establishment) of said road and (in case of alteration or establishment) designate the same as a Public (State—County—Township—Mail Route) road. It is further ordered that proper record be made of said road proceedings, survey and plat, and that the County Surveyor direct and require the Township Trustee of township through which said road or any portion thereof runs, in case of mail routes or township roads, or County Engineer in case of State or County roads, to cause the road to be Relocated.....for public travel.

ALSO, It is hereby ordered that the award of damages be, and the same is hereby made, in accordance with the assessment of Viewers as per their report, with the following exceptions, viz. :.....

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PROVIDED, That such sums shall become due and payable only upon the filing of a certificate from the Township Trustee or County Engineer, as the case may be, that the road has actually been opened for public travel.
